


Child Daycare Centre

- Toys and games for the children




The Child Daycare Centre: A Home Away from Home for the Children of the Institute's employees



Comfortable Ambience

Safety and security of young children is of the utmost priority to working mothers. The Institute provides a safe haven for the children, where they can spend the greater portion of the working day. This is also a boon to working mothers who are employees of the Institute, as they can concentrate on their daily working tasks and have the reassuring knowledge that their children are being well—looked after. The Daycare Centre has a comfortable room, which is fully safe, sanitized and with no health hazards for the young children. There is a comfortable bed, a soft mattress and pillows so that the children can be comfortable. The Centre is curtained so that the children can be protected from the glare of sunlight in the afternoons.

The Centre is well equipped with toys and games so that the children can keep engaged and spend time in joyeous play . They are also chosen with warm colours and inviting textures so that children find them attractive. The Centre has an experienced ayah who loves and takes care of the children. She also takes care of them at meal times and sees that they are comfortable. In case of any illnesses or minor injuries she also takes care and ministers to the children.
