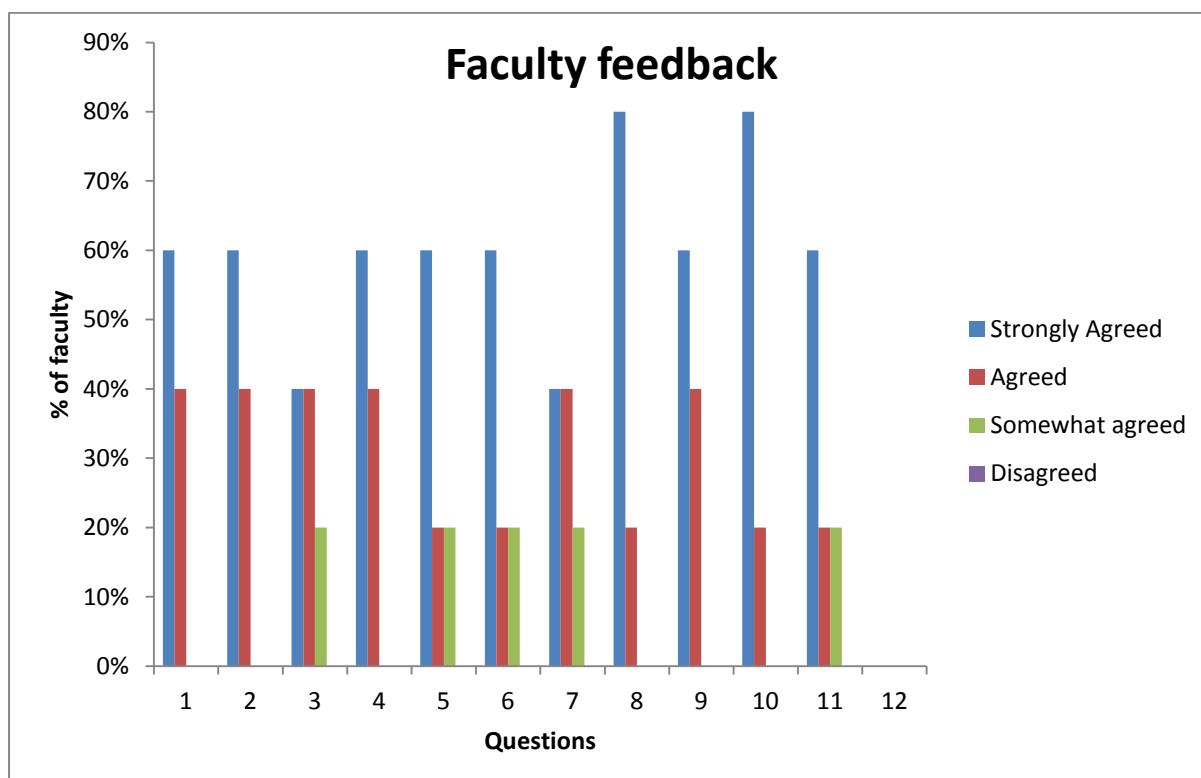

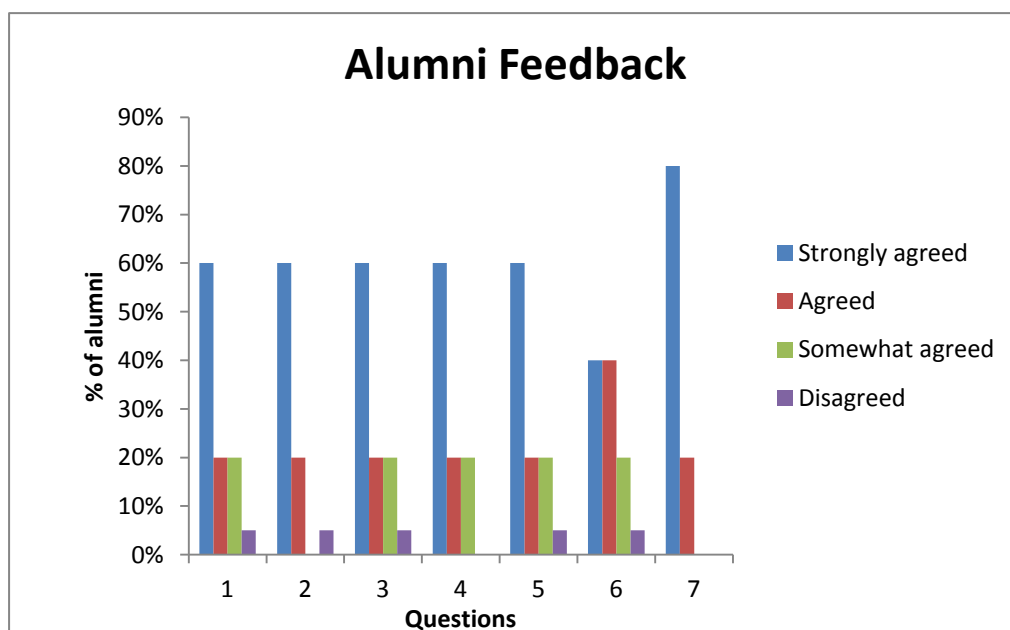

## **ACTION TAKEN REPORT**

- 10-30% of the content of the syllabus will be revised as per the stakeholder's feedback and industry requirement. This will be considered for each and every subject.
- Some new courses will be introduced in the R 16 curriculum for strengthening employability, entrepreneurship, technical and overall skills of the FT students.
- Overall focus will be kept on the organization of the curriculum design in such a way so that it well balances the concept based skills with that of the hands-on skills.
