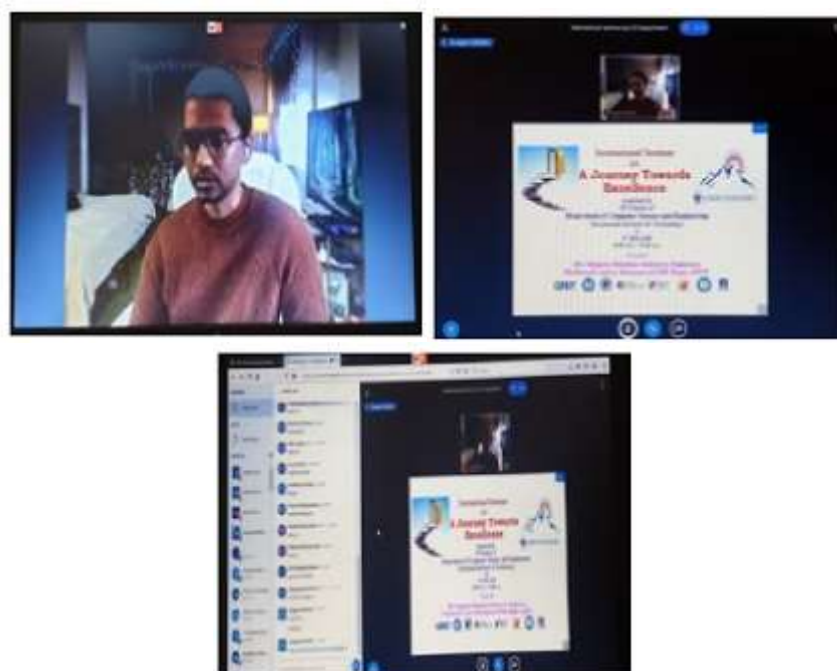
Alumni activity
