❖ Agenda 0 : To start day's proceedings

- Meeting started at 3.00 p.m. with the Welcome Address by the Principal, Prof.
 (Dr.) Santanu Kumar Sen, the Chairman of the council where he informed honourable members that digital platform where the meeting was held was developed by 2nd year CSE students of the institute itself. All appreciated.
 - Then he handed over the charge to the member secretary Dr. Sucharita Bhattacharyya, to conduct the day's proceedings.
- Member secretary welcomed the honourable members and with the permission to start the proceedings, intimated AC members about the leave of absence of 1 external member only, which was granted.

❖ Agenda 1 : To confirm and approve the minutes of the last AC meeting held on 5th December, 2019.

Member Secretary placed the minutes of the last AC meeting held on 5^{th} December , 2020 to the council members and it was confirmed and approved.

- **❖** Agenda 2 : To note and ratify the follow up action taken pursuant to the last meeting held on 5th December, 2019 which were appreciated by the council members.
- AC members suggested to include those topics in the syllabus which could motivate the students in R & D activities as well as could help them to acquire technical knowledge as per the requirement of industry.

In 5th and 6th sem. syllabus of the curriculum, two subjects are included namely, Project-V (PR 591) and Project VI (PR 691) respectively to motivate the students in Research & Developmental activities.

Similarly, the subject-specific innovative activities (PR 592) and (PR 692) are included in curriculum of 5th and 6th sem. respectively, which may improve industry-required technical knowledge status of the students.

As a query to the information of arrangement of 7-level test series in line with the industry requirements which started with baseline & preparatory practice tests from 1st year onwards, Prof. Roy & Prof. Chakraborty asked to confirm that whether during tests, students can access the internet or not.

It is confirmed by TNP Cell of GNIT that all the tests taken are proctored and once students click the examination link, they can't access internet any more.

• External experts suggested for Graphical result analysis & comparison with previous batch.

Accordingly, all result analysis were presented in the meeting.

- **❖** Agenda 3 : Approval of proposed Autonomy Curriculum and Syllabus for ongoing 5th and 6th sem. (2018-19) B.Tech. Courses as per AICTE 2018 model curriculum.
 - ➤ Proposed Autonomy Curriculum and Syllabus structure for 3rd year (both 5th & 6th sem.) B.Tech. Courses (ongoing batch) were finalized by the concerned departments, & HODs submitted the same to the AC members

for their suggestions, if any, and for probable approval for the present batch. AC external members enquired about the number of sessional and project papers distribution / semester & the corresponding credit points for all branches.

Point of Action: Concerned HODs

After detailed discussions, following points were suggested by the external experts.

- ➤ Industry expert Mr. Indranil Roy Chowdhury suggested to include the topics "Agile Methodology" in Operating Systems, "Session Management System "& "Scripting Language" in Web Technology Lab if possible, to fulfil the industry requirements for CSE, IT students.
- ➤ He also suggested to include New DBMS with No sequel, but with Mongo DV, Dynamic DV, and to introduce BASIC and Larger Algorithm for FT students, and enquired about the inclusion of Soft Computing for AEIE. HODs gave their messages.

Point of Action: IT, FT, CSE & AEIE HODs

➤ Prof. (Dr.) Rajat .Kumar De suggested to use plurals in the name of some subjects like DBM systems, Computer Networks, Operating Systems, Control Systems for various streams' syllabus. He also enquired about detailing of DSP syllabus, Power & Control systems syllabus.

Point of Action: CSE, EE & ECE HODs

➤ For ECE syllabus few points were raised like justification of 7 labs in 6th sem., necessity to include Machine learning in curriculum. Industry expert, Indranil Roy Chowdhury asked for real life problems to include here.

Point of Action: ECE HOD

➤ Constitution of India for FT is included in 6th sem. and credit should be same for all streams as common paper, as suggested by Prof. Amalendu Ghosh.

Point of Action: FT HOD

All members expressed their satisfaction of the overall examination system and the results of the students.
